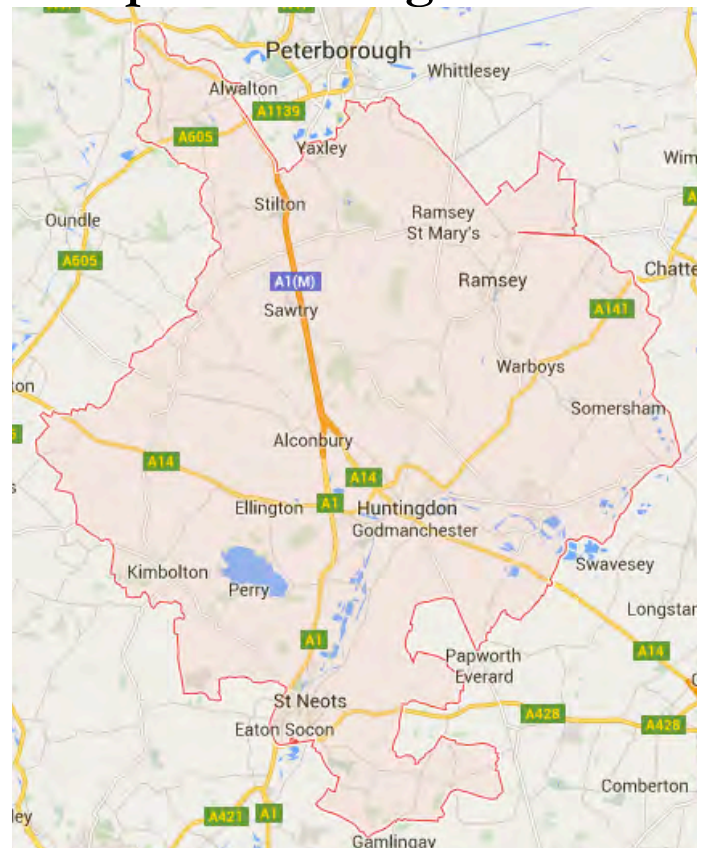
Rescues
